

# HISPANIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships open to Hispanic or Latino students.

## [Dr. Juan Andrade Scholarship for Young Hispanic Leaders](#)

**Sponsor:** United States Hispanic Leadership Institute (USHLI)

**Amount:** Up to \$1,000

**Closing Date:** November 30, 2023

**Description:** Scholarship is open to students enrolled or accepted for enrollment as a full-time student, in an accredited four-year or two-year institution in the U.S. or U.S. territories, and demonstrates a verifiable need for financial support. At least one parent must be of Hispanic ancestry. Non-U.S. citizens are eligible to apply (DACA or undocumented).

## [New Beginnings Esthetics Scholarship](#)

**Sponsor:** Dermalogica | Beauty Changes Lives Foundation

**Amount:** \$5,000

**Closing Date:** November 30, 2023

**Description:** Scholarship is open to students who are newly accepted or currently enrolled in an esthetics program at a Dermalogica partner school, and identify as Black, Indigenous, or persons of color.

**Amount:** \$5,000

**Closing Date:** December 1, 2023

**Description:** Scholarship is open to current college students majoring in Culinary Arts, Hospitality Management, or a closely related field. In addition to the general scholarship, there is a scholarship open to ethnic minority students.

**Description:** Scholarship is open to students enrolled or accepted at an accredited college, university, or graduate school in the United States. Applicant must have at least a 3.0 GPA. Student must submit a essay sharing a chapter of their life in which they took on a leadership role (as a basketball captain, volunteering leader, dance group leader, etc.)

**Amount:** Varies

**Closing Date:** December 19, 2023

**Description:** Scholarships are open to current undergraduate and graduate students with an interest in working in the water industry (engineering, research, etc.). In addition to the general scholarships, there are scholarships specifically for female students and minority students.

**Amount:** Varies

**Closing Date:** December 29, 2023

**Description:** Scholarships are open to students who plan to pursue a career in state/provincial or local government finance. Multiple scholarships available with different requirements. See website for details. In addition to the general scholarship, there is a scholarship specifically to minority students.

### [Jackie Robinson Foundation Scholarship](#)

**Amount:** Up to \$30,000 over four years

**Closing Date:** January 10, 2024

**Description:** Scholarship is open to graduating, minority high school seniors who plan on attending an accredited and approved four-year institution within the United States. Applicant must show leadership potential, dedication to community service, and evidence of financial need.

**Closing Date:** January 24, 2024

**Description:** Scholarship is open to incoming and current undergraduate and graduate students with at least a 2.8 GPA. There are a total of 11 scholarships with specific requirements. There are scholarships open to the following majors: Business, Finance, Marketing, Supply Chain, Computer Science, Engineering, Math, Science. There are also scholarships open to students who are African American/Black, Hispanic/Latinx,, Native American, or Asian/Pacific Islander.

**Description:** Scholarships are open to female graduating high school seniors who played golf in high school. There are scholarships for students who are planning on playing collegiate golf and for students not planning on playing collegiate golf. In addition to general scholarships, there are scholarships open to minority female students.

**Description:** Scholarship is open to current high school seniors who is eligible to attend a two or four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school. Applicant must have at least one

parent of Hispanic/Latino heritage, be a legal U.S. Resident, U.S. Citizen, or a DREAMer/DACA recipient, and have at least a 2.8 GPA.

### **LanguageCert International Student Scholarship**

**Amount:** \$5,000

**Closing Date:** March 31, 2024

**Description:** Scholarship is open to students who will be a freshman undergraduate student in fall 2024. Applicant must be an international student and show proof of English language proficiency to the HACU member school by means of the LanguageCert Academic test.

### **Macy's Emergency Scholarship Fund**

**Closing Date:** Rolling

**Description:** Scholarship is open to deserving students facing economic hardship and immediate monetary need that, if not met, could result in an inability to complete classes or a degree program. Emergency financial need resulting from the following will qualify students from funding: change in family income/support, loss of job, death of an immediate family member, natural disaster, pending eviction or home foreclosure, burglary, or fire. Applicant must be a resident of California, Florida, Missouri, New Mexico, New York, Ohio, Puerto Rico, or Texas.
