## PixelPlex Annual Scholarship

**Sponsor:** PixelPlex

**Amount:** \$2,000

**Closing Date:** December 5, 2023

**Description:** Scholarship is open to citizens and permanent residents of the United States who are incoming or current college students studying in a field of study related to science, technology, engineering, math (STEM), economics, or business.

## UNCF Social Justice Scholarship
