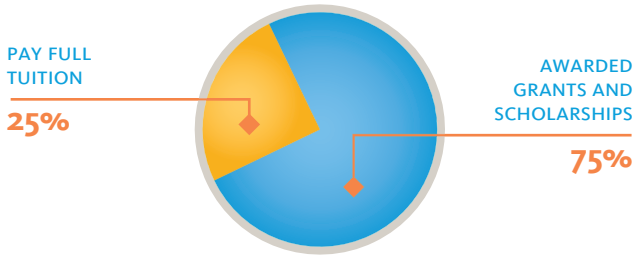

The net cost of attending UC – what you actually pay after grants and scholarships – may be the same as or less than other public universities.



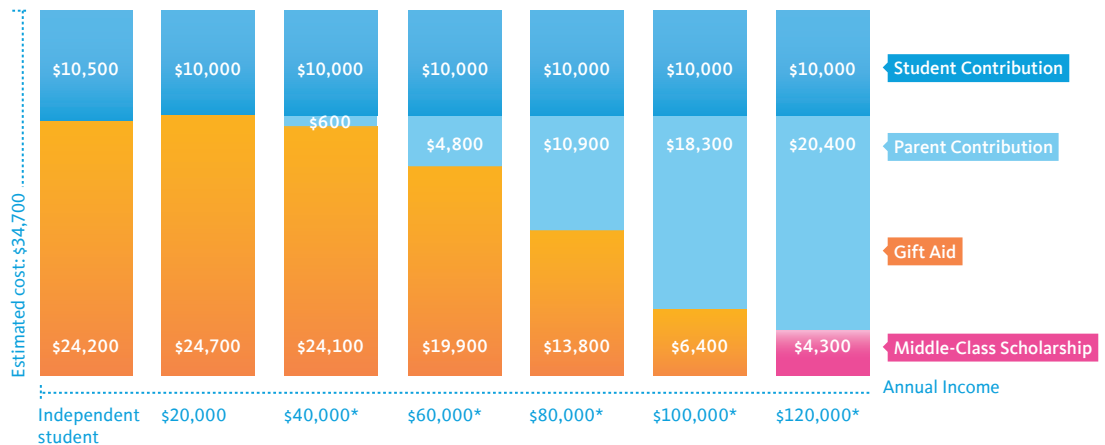
## ELIGIBLE CALIFORNIA STUDENTS WERE AWARDED NEARLY
